- . Graduates will be considered only for advanced courses specializations.
- . Applicants must be willing to study and stay in the Gauteng Province.
- . Applicants must be willing to undergo screening assessments for a non-refundable fee of **R 200.00**
- . Applicants must have no bad credit rating (**including debt incurred at other Universities**)
- . Applicants must have no criminal record.
- . Applicants must have SA Citizenship
